## White Grub Fact Sheet

Without a doubt, White Grubs are one of the most destructive of turf-grass pest, capable of destroying large areas of turf in a short period of time. Because they feed below the soil surface on the grasses root system, evidence of their presence is not usually seen until damage has been done. In the past, the only way to control Grubs was curatively, targeting young grubs, using short residual chemicals. If the timing was too early, the residues would degrade before the grubs hatched. If it was too late, the large grubs would have already caused damage and be hard to control. Now however, due to the development of new long residual, low toxicity chemicals that are preventatively applied before egg hatch (June 10 to July 25), excellent (90%) control is possible and the high cost of repairing damaged areas can be saved.
